Student Re-Enrollment Fee: The returning student early enrollment fee is \$75 per student. This is non-refundable and is due March 1, 2010. Beginning March 2, 2010 the re-enrollment fee will be \$150.00.

New Student Application Fee: This fee is \$90 per new student and submitted at the time of initial application. This fee is non-refundable. New student applicants that have been tested and interviewed will not receive official acceptance until after March 1, 2010, allowing our current students to secure their placement.

New Student Registration Fee: Upon acceptance, a registration fee of \$75 per student is due in order to secure their placement. This is non-refundable.

Payments: The student fee is added to the annual tuition and apportioned according to your choice of payment plan. (See below) **Payments are made to the school and due on the first of each month.** School payments are established by choices made on the enrollment agreement. (See enrollment agreement for exact calculations). **The first payment is due June 1, 2010. This payment is non-refundable.**

Payment Plans: There are five payment plans available: payment in full, payment by semester, or 10, 11, or 12 equal monthly payments made by check, ACH Direct Debit or Credit Card Auto Debit.

The first payment is due June 1, 2010. The remaining payments start in July, August, or September depending on which monthly plan you choose. All accounts must be paid in full by May 31 of each year.

Discounts: Families that return (all children) will receive a 2.5% discount off of published tuition rates (This discount also applies to children who go from WCS preschool to WCS kindergarten). Families who refer a new, full-time (K-12) student will receive a \$500 credit per new student with a maximum credit of \$1,000 (This discount only applies if the child is accepted and attends WCS).

Student Fee: These fees cover textbooks, workbooks, classroom and art supplies, achievement testing, building use, computer equipment, etc.

Parent Service Hours: Each WCS family with one or more full time students is required to serve 30 hours of time over the course of the school year. Single parents and parents with only one student in a half day program are required to serve 15 hours. All hours not completed by the end of the school year will be billed at \$15 per hour. Parents are responsible for logging their time in binders that are kept on the counter in the school office.

Financial Aid: A limited amount of financial aid is available. These grants are based on financial need. All applications should be submitted by April 20, 2010 for the 2010-2011 school year. If approved, notification will be sent out during the month of May or upon acceptance to WCS. Applications and additional information are available in the school office.

Billing: The accounts receivable policy for all families is as follows:

- High School students are not allowed to take semester exams if financial, athletic and library accounts are not current.
- Accounts must be current at the end of each quarter for families to receive a report card, have access to our online grade book and continue with WCS in the following quarter.
- All accounts are charged a \$25.00 late fee per family if payment is received later than the tenth of the month.
- Accounts with returned checks are charged a \$25.00 fee, which is over and above the late fee.
- Records are not released to parents unless all accounts are current.

New Student (mid-year)

- If a new student enrolls before September 1, **a full year of tuition and fees will be charged**, payable with the terms chosen on the tuition agreement .
- After September 1, the tuition and student fees are pro-rated by the percentage of the remaining portion of the school year.
- Two tuition plans are available for new students that start after school begins.
 - ◇ **Plan 1 – One Payment.** The total payment (tuition, student fee) is due on or before the student's first day of school.
 - ◇ **Plan 2 – Monthly Payments.** The first payment is non-refundable and will include the Student fee and *Tuition*. The first payment will be due on or before the student's first day of school. The remaining payments will be on the first day of each month following the first payment and continuing through May 1.

Foreign Student: Please ask for additional information from the School office.

Admission Requirements

Application: Parents must complete and submit an application for enrollment and the \$90 non-refundable fee prior to testing.

Admissions Testing: Students are given an initial entrance exam. Appointments may be scheduled throughout the year.

Family/Student Interview: All applicants and their parents/guardians will be asked to visit the school. This important part of the admissions process allows the school and family to become better acquainted. Applicants, along with their family, will interview with the principal and/or lead teacher. Administration will call each applicant family to set up a time for this interview.

Minimum Requirements: Applicants for Kindergarten must be 5 years of age by December 1, 2010.

Admission Summary: Qualified students are accepted on the basis of space availability and other factors.

PROCESS FOR NEW STUDENTS

- Application and non-refundable fee submitted
- School reference forms returned by the appropriate parties.
- Current report card submitted or, for those applying to high school, current transcripts
- Copy of immunization record given to WCS
- Date set for entrance evaluation
- Interview with principal or vice-principal
- Notification from WCS of the student's status for enrollment
