Woodland Christian High School is a private four-year coeducational high school that was established in 1999. The school is accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC) and the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI). The staff includes 1 administrator, 1 principal, 1 academic counselor, 1 dean of students, 16 teachers, 2 administrative assistants, and an IT support specialist.

### Student Ethnicity

The student body's cultural diversity includes the following: 57% Caucasian, 19% Latinx, 14% Biracial, 6% Asian/Pacific Islander, 2% Native American, and 2% African American.

Total enrollment is 219 students with 50 seniors, 42 juniors, 61 sophomores and 63 freshmen.

### COMMUNITY PROFILE

Woodland Christian High School is a private school in the agricultural community of Woodland. There are two public high schools in Woodland. The majority of Woodland Christian High School's student population is from Woodland, but the school also has students enrolled from the neighboring communities of Antelope, Arbuckle, Brooks, Carmichael, Capay, Davis, Dixon, Dunnigan, Elverta, Esparto, Guinda, Knights Landing, Natomas, Sacramento, Williams, Winters, Yolo, and Zamora.

### CURRICULUM

Woodland Christian High School has a full A-G, University of California-approved curriculum. We have three types of diplomas, the Regular Diploma, the College Preparatory Diploma and the Scholar Diploma. The school operates on a block schedule. Four classes meet each "A" day, and alternate with the four classes that are held each "B" day. From the fall of 2009 through spring of 2015, seven classes were offered per semester using the block schedule. Since fall of 2015, eight classes have been offered per semester. Chapel services are held on campus weekly.
